INFORMATION ABOUT THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING

The Annual Parish Meeting (“APM”), convened by the Chairman of the Parish Council, is a community meeting and NOT a Parish Council meeting, which is very different. All local government electors registered in the area can participate in the meeting and decisions are made by a majority of those present. Though an APM may discuss parish affairs, its resolutions differ in their legal consequences from those of the Parish Council. In most cases the resolutions are persuasive only.

A Parish Meeting may address any public matter of local interest but, apart from this, our annual meetings also provide a forum for the Parish Council, and others, to highlight local activities over the last year that might be of interest.
